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
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Introduction

Modality

The zodiac signs fall under one of three modalities and deal with the way their lives or approaches differ:

- Cardinal — Aries, Cancer, Libra, Capricorn
- Fixed — Taurus, Leo, Scorpio, Aquarius
- Mutable — Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius, Pisces

Cardinal signs are born leaders, always initiating things and willing to encourage change and transformation. Fixed signs are firm in all they do. They persevere no matter what, and their focus is unlike anyone else's. The mutable signs are the most adaptable. Regardless of what you throw at them, they are flexible, and it is this trait that makes them some of the most resilient people you'll ever meet.

Elements

Zodiac signs are also connected to the four classical elements — earth, water, air, and fire.

- Earth signs — Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn
- Water signs — Pisces, Cancer, Scorpio
- Air signs — Libra, Aquarius, Gemini

- Fire signs — Aries, Sagittarius, Leo

Earth signs are cautious, but that shouldn't be interpreted negatively. They think before they act. They are some of the most productive people you'll meet in life, and are quite materialistic (in a good way), meaning you can trust they will do everything they can to ensure all relevant needs are taken care of, including the state of nature. They see things as they are and are great at ensuring things aren't just started but seen through to completion. People with earth signs are also pretty sensuous.

Water signs are all about their emotions and are very aware. They are some of the most sensitive people you'll meet, very in touch with how they feel. Their intuition is off the charts, and they're usually empaths. They're also very interested in spiritual matters and vulnerable — which can be a strength in the right circumstances.

Air signs are very intellectual people. They are about being social and some of the brightest minds you'll ever encounter. They are fascinated by life, curious about everything, and always gathering information like it's running out. They love to test different ideas and enjoy rubbing their minds with others. Considering the Planets

Each planet has its unique energy that affects each sign differently. Before we go over each one, let's link each zodiac sign to its ruling planet:

- Aries — Mars
- Taurus — Venus
- Gemini — Mercury
- Cancer — Moon
- Leo — Sun
- Virgo — Mercury
- Libra — Venus

- Scorpio — Pluto (according to modern astrology), Mars (according to traditional astrology)
- Sagittarius — Jupiter
- Capricorn — Saturn
- Aquarius — Uranus (according to modern astrology), Saturn (according to traditional astrology)
- Pisces — Neptune (according to modern astrology), Jupiter (according to traditional astrology)

Now let's look at the effect of each celestial body.

The Sun: This is the ruler of all things, and it is an energizer. It drives everything we are at our core, so when we embrace our sun sign, we feel happy and content with life. The sun is in charge of your true purpose, creativity, conscious mind, masculine energy, and sense of self.

The Moon: The sign associated with the moon changes every 2.5 days, so it's possible to find Cancers are ruled by or connected to any of the other signs born in the same year. The moon is all about emotions and sensitivity. It is where you get the empathetic aspect of yourself, and the emotions it is tied to are the ones we have trouble expressing. It represents our shadow side, which we are only vulnerable enough to reveal to those we feel safe with. It rules feminine energy, all emotions, and instincts.

Mercury: There's more to this planet than it's in retrograde, which everyone and their grandma like to blame for their bad choices. However, there's more to this planet than flipping your life upside down. nothing, red being the color of passion, fire, and intensity. This planet drives our primal desires.

Jupiter: This planet rules positivity and optimism. It's in charge of good luck, abundance, and true growth. When you have this planet influencing your life, you'll likely experience amazing benefits. It's about travel and the exploration of philosophy through learning and teaching. It asks you to become more expansive by learning from life, books, and spirituality. It's the planet that inspires you to go after your grandest ideas.

Saturn: Think of this planet as the dad energy to the moon's mom energy. This strict planet is about discipline, love expressed in tough situations, drawing boundaries, and angst. Its energy could represent a challenge, but it will help you evolve into more of who you truly are and learn to take more responsibility in your life. It's about hard work and persevering to overcome your challenges.



Day 30: when you eat, be more mindful and present. Pay attention to the colors, smells, and textures as you eat.


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
